Venue, general map of the region, embargoed area, old maps

The <u>event centre</u> is located 58 km from Tartu, 30 km from Põlva and 25 km from Võru in Kärgula village, Urvaste parish.

The biggest part of <u>event area</u> is located in Jõgehara village, Kanepi parish – southeast part of Estonia.

Road signs will be on Tartu-Võru road (E263) in Erastvere 57.97113, 26.78452 and in Lajavangu 57.96757, 26.75819.

Registration and participants

September 23rd – final date for entries and payment

The organizers will leave 1-2 reserve places at the beginning of each competition class start list. Entry fee for latecomers: up to 2 times of the normal entry fee.

The IOF rule WRE 6.2a will be complied: Competitors who are citizens of a country which does not have an IOF member, or are citizens of a country where the IOF Member is suspended, may apply to compete as an IOF Independent Athlete (IIA). They must satisfy the requirements for IIA status (including payment of an annual administration fee) as published by the IOF.

Other classes participants' restriction

Decision of the Board of Commissioners of EOL no. 48: According to the decision of the IOF Council on 28.02.2022 to suspend the membership of the Russian and Belarusian orienteering federations in the IOF, citizens of the mentioned countries, who were not members of EOL clubs before 24.02.2022, are not allowed to participate in the Estonian championships and the IOF ranking competitions held

in Estonia (WRE). As the only exception, from July 1, 2024, Russian and Belarusian orienteers with IIA status are allowed to compete in WRE competitions held in Estonia, which do not take place at the same time as the Estonian championships.

Terrain

The competition terrain offers the mostly forested landscape. The height difference on the map is 30 m, on one slope 20 m. The passability of the forest varies within wide limits, the best passability is around 60-year-old pine forests, the most difficult to pass are storm break nests and low marshes with willow bushes.

Mapped with a 2,5 m contour interval. In some part of terrain has micro-relief.

Map scale

MN21E classes: 1:15 000 (long distance), 1:10 000 (middle distance),

Other classes: from 1:5000 (marked courses) to 1:10 000. More detailed information about the map

scale used in other classes will be published before the end of the registration period.

Contour interval 2,5 m.

Punching system and GPS-tracking

Punching system: SPORTident punching system will be used. Touch-free punching is switched on. The technical specification for maximum distance to record a punch is 30 cm.

SportIdent cards are available to hire at the registration, hire fee 2 € per day.

Missing SIAC Cards will be charged with 80 €/card.

GPS-tracking: On all races, selected runners will be carrying GPS devices. On-line results will be available.

Bib numbers

All classes use bib numbers. Race class, name, SI number reported at registration, and start times of both days are printed on the bib numbers of pre-registered competitors. Bib numbers can be obtained

from the arena either on a rope (start fee paid) or after paying the start fee at the information tent. Competitors must have safety pins with them to attach the bib number.

Prize giving

Sum of both days: first three runners in each class (except Open classes) are awarded. The awards are presented by the store chain Magaziin (www.magaziin.ee)
